## **Company Law & Administration**

## Course Outcome:

- 1. Explain the concepts and principles of Company Law, including the formation of a company, Articles of Association, and the doctrine of constructive notice.
- 2. Analyze the differences between a Joint Stock Company, Private Company, and Public Company, and understand the legal requirements and implications of each.
- 3. Evaluate the provisions for CSR activities under Schedule VII of the Companies Act 2013, and assess the impact of corporate social responsibility on business operations.
- 4. Demonstrate knowledge of the registration of prospectus, capital structure, and accounts of companies, and understand the rules regarding the issue of debentures.
- 5. Discuss the administrative and managerial role of a company, including the appointment of directors, Director Identification Number (DIN), Managing Director, Whole Time Directors, and Company Secretary.
- 6. Explain the requirements for corporate meetings, including the requisite of a valid meeting, and analyze the responsibilities and powers of the Board of Directors (BODs).
- 7. Evaluate the different modes of winding up a company and understand the legal implications of each method.
