

## **Company Law & Administration**

### Course Outcome:

1. Explain the concepts and principles of Company Law, including the formation of a company, Articles of Association, and the doctrine of constructive notice.
2. Analyze the differences between a Joint Stock Company, Private Company, and Public Company, and understand the legal requirements and implications of each.
3. Evaluate the provisions for CSR activities under Schedule VII of the Companies Act 2013, and assess the impact of corporate social responsibility on business operations.
4. Demonstrate knowledge of the registration of prospectus, capital structure, and accounts of companies, and understand the rules regarding the issue of debentures.
5. Discuss the administrative and managerial role of a company, including the appointment of directors, Director Identification Number (DIN), Managing Director, Whole Time Directors, and Company Secretary.
6. Explain the requirements for corporate meetings, including the requisite of a valid meeting, and analyze the responsibilities and powers of the Board of Directors (BODs).
7. Evaluate the different modes of winding up a company and understand the legal implications of each method.
